

- Breanna: Noticed 1/3 spent on professional/consulting fees. Do you see this slowing, accelerating, or? Jesus believes we will continue to see expenditures. These expenditures are in line with approved contracts and board approvals.

There are some expenditures related to district salaries, but these are inline with work being done related to the bond project. It is difficult to see properly because of the software coding. There are individual master plans by site. Additional plans are still in process. Jesus's team will work to post Bond projects which have been approved by the board, expenditure reports, as well as the facility plans on the website.
